

- 3. Applications are evaluated in the order they are received; only complete applications will be processed.
- 4. Upon acceptance into the program, the applicant must submit a \$100\* admission fee (non-refundable) to assure a seat in the next available session.
- 5. Applicants will be notified of the Admission Committee's decision by mail. If you are not selected, you may re-apply the following year.



## Lead Safety for Remodeling, Repair, and Painting (RRP) EPA Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP Rule) Renovator *Initial* Training Course

Effective April 22, 2010, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires that all landlords, contractors, property management firms, or handymen who do renovation, remodeling or painting work, in pre-1978 housing or child occupied facilities, complete Lead Safety for Remodeling, Repair and Painting (RRP) training.

The EPA requires firms performing renovation, repair, and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in pre-1978 homes, child care facilities, and schools be certified by the EPA and that they use certified renovators who are trained by the EPA-approved training providers to follow lead-safe work practices.

Individuals can become certified renovators by taking this eight hour course which is EPA - approved.


