Successful Classroom Collaboration:

"Moby Dick" Glogster Project

Students in Mrs. DiBartolo's class were able to creatively express their new understanding of the literary elements in "Moby Dick" by using the Web 2.0 tool, **Glogster**, to create their final products. After reading the book, the students learned about elements

such as point of view, characters, plot and setting. The students then created interactive multimedia posters, using animated graphics, pictures, text bubbles, and links to external websites to express their understanding of each element.


