Interests: Displays the Holland interest codes associated with the occupation. For example, an interest in "realistic occupations" is linked to pursuit in working in jobs that require athletic or mechanical ability, working with objects, etc.

Work Values: Work environments and values associated with the occupation.

Tasks: Work activities that are specific to the occupation.

Duties: Job behaviors, describing activities that occur on multiple occupations.

Tools and Technology: Commonly associated with the occupation.

Skills: Capacities developed through education and experience that help perform the occupation.

Knowledge: Organized principles and facts that apply to a wide range of situations, such as knowledge of "English language," "mechanical," or "computer and electronics."

Work Context: Allows users to view how important a physical or social factor is to this occupation.

Work Styles: Allows users to view how important personal work characteristics can affect how well a worker is likely to perform in this occupation.

Education: Group occupations into 5 Job Zones based on the level of education, experience and training necessary to perform the occupation.

School Programs: Links to Training programs for that particular occupation and list of NY Colleges which offer degrees for that particular occupation.

Wages: Most current and reliable, New York State specific wage information and employment forecast.
